#### **GENERAL THEORY: EXPO (2004)**

A sculptural, graphic, and sound work that restages an installation originally sited at *The Sculpture Center*, NY as part of *Treble* (curated by Regine Basha). Jacques Derrida's essay, "Structure, Sign, and Play in the Discourse of the Human Sciences," (1966) is read aloud by a female voice actor. The installation included vinyl wall signage, a stainless steel column, and framed prints.

The voice is interrupted by noise generated by an audio-design program that translated The Whitney's floor plans and elevations into sound.

#### DE INDRINGER/THE INTRUDER (2004)




